DETAILS

- Font: size 12 Calibri or Times New Roman front
- Spelling and punctuation: please use Australia/British spelling and punctuation
- Margins: Margins should be exactly 2.5cm (1 inch)
- Title: Use bold for your article title, with an initial capital letter for any proper nouns
- Abstract: Indicate the abstract with a heading in italics. Your abstract should be between 150–200 words long, and should demonstrate the scope and outcomes of your paper.
- Keywords: Keywords help your readers locate your article. Include five or six specific keywords directly under the abstract.
- Referencing: Salus Journal uses APA7, with in-text citations and a Reference List at the end of your manuscript.

HEADINGS

- First-level headings (e.g. Introduction, Conclusion) should be in bold, with an initial capital letter for any proper nouns.
- Second-level headings should be in bold italics, with an initial capital letter for any proper nouns.
- Third-level headings should be in bold italics, with an initial capital letter for any proper nouns.
- Ensure your manuscript has headings for the abstract, introduction, methodology, findings, conclusions, and references – or variations thereof.

TABLES AND FIGURES

- Tables and figures should be included in the body of the manuscript where relevant. If you have a substantial number of tables and figures, contact the editors-in-chief to discuss if they would be better placed at the end of the manuscript.

DATA AVAILABILITY

- If you are submitting a data availability statement, include it at the end of your conclusion, but before the references.
